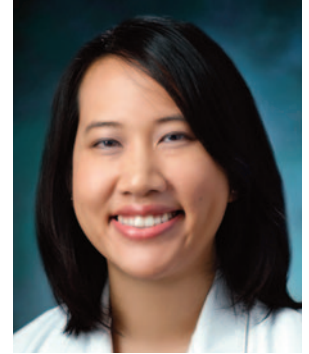
Connect with mentors, colleagues, and other professionals at the **Networking Reception**, **Special Interest Group** meetings, and the **Saturday Night Celebration**.

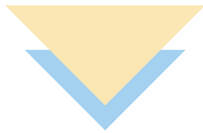

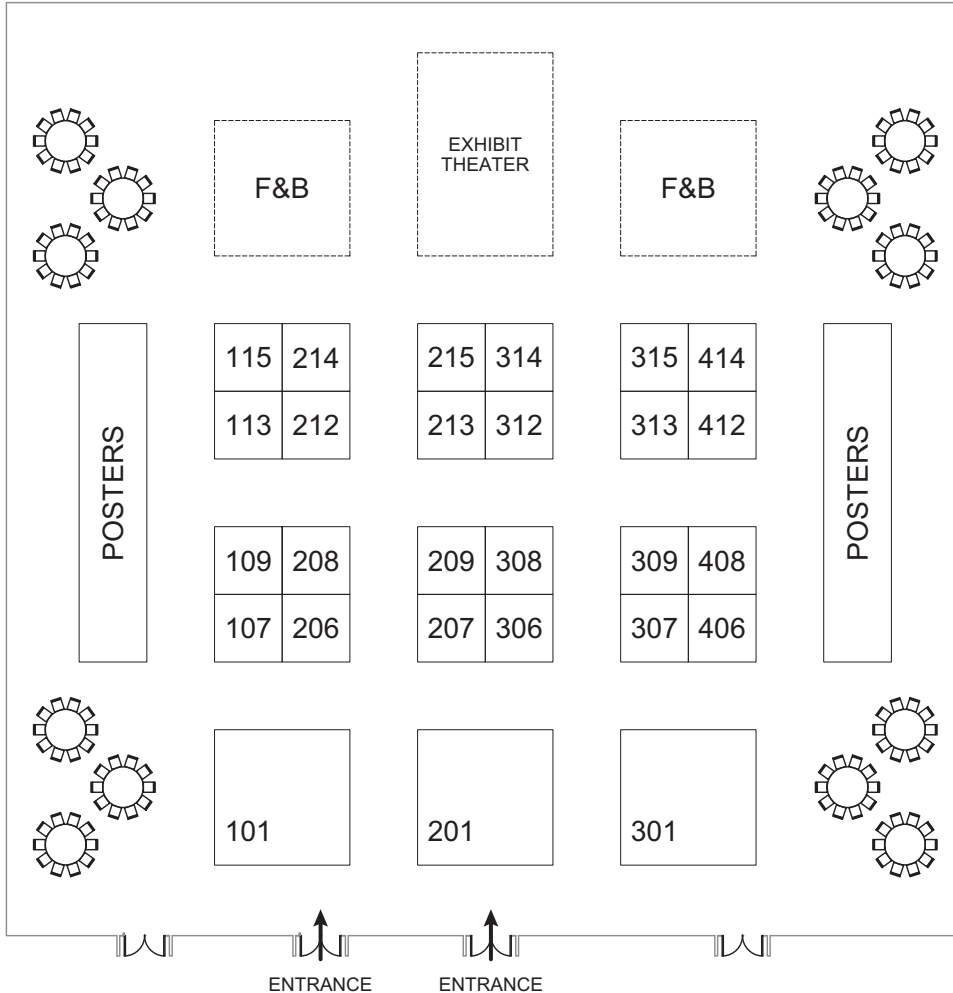

ASRA Pain Medicine Guidelines for Assignment of Space: The priority points system has been established to fairly assign space at all ASRA Pain Medicine meetings and events. Point totals are based on the 12 months preceding June 17, 2026, the date booking forms must be received to benefit from the point system.
